
Art for Induction is a therapeutic arts based resource specifically designed to support schools with settling new arrivals. It was commissioned by the Equalities Team and produced by experienced Art for Wellbeing practitioners from Cartwheels Arts using the Design-Thinking ideology that embeds a clear understanding of individual experience into the development process. It is a fully researched and tested resource that was co-produced with children who have experience in starting school after migrating from their home countries.

The resource is designed for use across key stages and offers a range of differentiated material to suit individual need.
