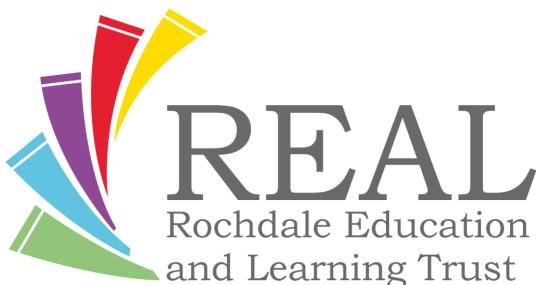
1. Geography: Context, Website, Attainment
